Prudence Defined

The simple believes every word, but the prudent considers well his steps (Proverbs 14:15)

The Value of Prudence

A prudent man foresees evil and hides himself, but the simple pass on and are punished. (Proverbs 22:3)

Learning from Consequences

When the scoffer is punished, the simple is made wise; but when the wise is instructed, he receives knowledge. (Proverbs 21:11)
